 - A single-face 96" x 39" aluminum wall sign with raised lettering
 - A 28" x 11.5" aluminum blade sign
 - A window graphics package for front door/windows
- Supply and install three (3) gooseneck lights, including all electric work (wiring, supplies, etc.) to connect lighting – gooseneck lights to illuminate wall sign from above
- Supply and install three (3) 6" LED canopy lights, providing any electric work necessary
